

Children of critical workers and vulnerable children who can access onsite provision at Mosaic Jewish Primary School.

Updated 5 January 2021

Following the [Prime Minister's announcement on 4 January 2021](#), only children of critical workers and vulnerable children and young people should attend school or college. All other pupils and students will receive remote education.

High Priority

Vulnerable children and young people include those who:

- have a child in need plan, a child protection plan or who are a looked-after child
- have an education, health and care (EHC) plan
- children receiving support from children's social care services or in the process of being referred to children's services
- adopted children or children on a special guardianship order
- those at risk of exclusion
- families living in temporary accommodation.
- children who are young carers
- others at the schools and/or local authority's discretion including pupils who need to attend to receive support or manage risks to their mental health.
- Critical Workers of Health and Social Care (Front line staff)
- Critical Workers of Education and Childcare. (Front line staff)
- Critical Workers of Public safety and national security (Front line staff)

Medium Priority

- Critical Workers of Health and Social Care (Support staff)
- Critical Workers of Education and Childcare. (Support staff)
- Critical workers of Key Public services including where no parents are working at home including:
 - those essential to the running of the justice system; religious staff; charities and workers; delivering key frontline services; those responsible for the management of the deceased; journalists and broadcasters who are providing public service broadcasting.
- Critical workers of Local and national government
 - the coronavirus (COVID-19) response, and the delivery of and response to EU transition
 - essential public services, such as the payment of benefits and the certification or checking of goods for import and export (including animal products, animals, plants and food), including in government agencies and arms length bodies
- Critical workers of Food and other necessary goods
 - This includes those involved in food: production; processing; distribution; sale and delivery; as well as those essential to the provision of other key goods (for example hygienic and veterinary medicines)
- Critical Workers of Public safety and national security (Support staff)
- Critical Workers of Transport and border (Front line staff)

Low Priority

- Critical Workers of Transport and border (Support staff)
- Critical Works of Utilities, communication, and financial services (Front line staff)
- Children who had difficulty engaging with remote education during the March 2020 lockdown.

The school may ask you to provide evidence in order validate your request.
