MJPS – Making a Difference

As a committee member of the Friends of Mosaic I commit to the following responsibilities and behaviour:-

- 1) I will respect the confidentiality of any information or data that I am made party to in the course of carrying out my responsibilities and will not divulge any information about the School, its plans, its personnel, its staff or pupils' details without approval from the Chair of Governors or the Headteacher;
- 2) I will respect the views of others in and out of meetings treating all members of the school community equally and making sure their individual rights are respected
- 3) I will work consistently and in support of the school's policies and procedures, including promotion of the inclusive Jewish ethos of the school and all people's observance of the Sabbath and festivals.
- 4) I will not allow my own political opinions to interfere with the work of the school.
- 5) I accept that the FoM may not display political posters, including election material, in areas of the school premises to which the public has access.
- 6) I acknowledge that my use of social media, in whatever form, must not prejudice the good standing of the school, its staff and pupils. Accordingly, political opinions must not be publicised by me via social media in such a way as to suggest that I am either representing the views of the school or otherwise speaking in a representative capacity on behalf of the school. I further acknowledge that any breach of this code will be considered as a serious matter and may result in the Governing Body asking me to stand down from my position.
- 7) I will work in partnership with the school respecting the life and work demands on parents and the school staff so that any requests from the FoM for assistance will be scheduled well ahead.

MJPS is a non- political Jewish faith–based school that lives and promotes the British values of tolerance, respect and justice. Any political statements or actions by members of the Mosaic community are personal and do not reflect the views of MJPS.
